THE PROTECTION OF MINORS AND THE PROVISION OF A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL PROGRAMS IN WHICH MINORS ARE PRESENT IS THE UTMOST CONCERN OF THE PARISH OF BLESSED SACRAMENT AND THE CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF RICHMOND. IN PURSUING THIS GOAL, ALL PERSONS SERVING IN PROGRAMS WHICH INVOLVE CHILDREN WHO ARE 18 YEARS OR OLDER ARE PROVIDED TRAINING IN SAFE ENVIRONMENT ISSUES THROUGH VIRTUS, A NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM. THESE SESSIONS ARE HELD AT BLESSED SACRAMENT AND VARIOUS LOCATIONS AROUND THE

CHILDREN'S CHURCH: THIS IS AN INTRODUCTION TO THE CATHOLIC FAITH FOR CHILDREN 3-5 YEARS OLD, OFFERED ON SUNDAYS DURING THE 9:00 A.M. & 11:00 A.M. MASSES - OCTOBER - MAY. RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (R.C.I.A.) ASSISTS ADULTS (18 YEARS OLD AND OLDER) 1) WHO ARE NOT BAPTIZED, 2) WHO HAVE BEEN BAPTIZED IN OTHER CHRISTIAN DENOMINATIONS AND 3) WHO HAVE BEEN BAPTIZED IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH BUT HAVE NOT BEEN CATECHIZED. THE PROCESS BEGINS EACH FALL, AND INCLUDES WEEKLY SESSIONS ON TUESDAYS THAT INCLUDE INSTRUCTION, PRAYER AND SCRIPTURE STUDY, RETREATS, BLESSINGS AND PRAYER

THROUGH THE PROCESS AS RESOURCES AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PARISH. SPONSORS SHOULD BE FULLY INITIATED (CONFIRMED), PRACTICING CATHOLICS IN GOOD STANDING IN THE CHURCH.
